Start of Term 4 2023

We trust that you and your child/ward have had a good break and that he/she is ready to start the final and shortest term of the year.

N-Level, O-Level Exams and Sec 1-3 End-of-Year Exams

Our graduating classes are preparing for their upcoming exams this term. N-Level exams begin on 12 Sep and end on 13 Oct with an exam break from 22 Sep to 10 Oct. During this time, a customised timetable for Sec 4G and 4H (from 21/22 Sep respectively to 29 Sep) will help them prepare for the 2nd part of their exams. The last day of school for our graduating class will be 29 Sep, i.e., day of the Sec 4/5 Thanksgiving Service.

The O-Level Science practical exams start on 4 Oct and the written papers will begin on 18 Oct. Last day of the O-Level exam is 10 Nov. Students taking the O-Levels will have a study break from 2 Oct till their first paper. During this period, in addition to their Science Practical exam days, the school will also conduct timed practice papers for them with teachers' feedback thereafter. These sessions are optional and will be on a sign-up basis. However, students have to turn up in full school uniform. More details will be shared with them nearer the study break.

End-of-Year exams for the Sec 1s, 2s and 3s will start on 29 Sep and end on 12 Oct. As we help our students to prepare for the upcoming exams, we are mindful that they need plenty of love and encouragement from both parents and teachers. We believe our students will do their best and we will support them as best as we can. [Please note that the last Blended Learning day for the year will be held on 18 Sep.]

Thanksgiving

As a tradition, our school has been instilling in our students the importance of gratitude and giving of thanks. To this end, there will be two Thanksgiving services which will be held at the end of the term. The Sec 4/5 Thanksgiving Service will be held on 29 Sep (before the start of the O-Level Exams) while the Sec 1-3 Thanksgiving will be held on 27 Oct.

We have had 3 very busy and fulfilling terms this year and we expect Term 4 to be just as exciting and eventful. Trips for Internationalisation Experience will resume after 3 years. Camps and CCA training will also continue after the exams. Do continue to partner us to help our students flourish as a community of self-directed learners, influential leaders and caring citizens.
