Please take note of the following as you prepare your child/ward for the first day of school.

School Start Time

School starts at 7:40am and students should arrive 15 minutes before 7:40am so that they can locate their new classroom. Students should also bring along a book to read as they wait for assembly to begin.

School Attire

Sec 2-5 students will report to school in full school uniform (and ties for the boys) with proper haircut and colour. Secondary 1 students will come in their PE attire for the Orientation programme.

Orientation and Start Right Programme

The first week of school is normally filled with a lot of excitement as we welcome the new Sec 1 students with the Orientation Programme. The rest of the school has a similar Start Right Programme which looks at getting students and teachers to know one another, establish rapport and set the tone for a time of learning with one another for the year ahead. Please see attached for information on the attire and end of day for each level.

Road Safety and Traffic

We seek your cooperation to ensure the safety of students coming to and leaving school. Parents who drive your children to school should:

- 1. Reduce vehicle speed and stay alert for pedestrians in the school zone.
- 2. Cooperate with the security guards to ensure overall safety and smooth traffic flow.
- 3. Let your child alight only at the designated drop-off point which is at the end of the Technical Block. Do not let your child alight at the car park area as it will cause obstruction and pose a hazard.
- 4. Reinforce correct road safety behaviour and remind your children to use pedestrian crossings, and avoid jaywalking or using a mobile phone while crossing the road.

We do not encourage students to cycle to school. Students who want to must seek permission from their parent/guardian and submit a letter of consent signed by the parent/guardian.

Please note that <u>you will not be able to drive into the school compound after 7:40am</u>. If you have to pick your child/ward up after school, do wait at a location that is away from the school.

Be Socially Responsible

If your child/ward is not feeling well, i.e., has flu-like symptoms or has a sore throat, fever, do consult a doctor. Do also remind your child/ward to bring his/her thermometer to school. Please check that it is in working order and that the battery is fine. There will be a temperature taking exercise on 9 and 11 January.
